



Cycling Sports Competition for Citizens: Rules for Road Races

Tour de Okinawa will be held in accordance with rules established by JCF (Japan Cycling Federation).

Time limits are established at several points throughout the race course and riders will be eliminated from the race if they fail to go through those points by those specified times.

1. Riders' rights and responsibilities:

- ◆ Follow the race regulations and the Traffic Law of Japan.
- ◆ Riders who cause damages to others' or public properties are liable for the damages even during the race.
- ◆ Enter the race with a bicycle which has been well-maintained.
- ◆ Riders may lend, borrow or exchange foods, drinks, tools, bicycle parts, etc.
- ◆ Riders may take advantage of services provided by the organizer's neutral cars.
- ◆ Have words and conducts of sportsmanship all the time.

2. Refreshments

◆ Refreshment shall be supplied at fixed feeding stations, located at two points below:

- ◆ The organizer will provide water or energy drink at those stations: (Plastic bottles with blue label: energy drink; without label: water)
- ◆ Discard the provided bottles at designated points

3. Neutral Vehicle

- ◆ The organizer provides neutral vehicle services (automobiles and motorcycles) that supply spare wheels. Spare wheels are of SHIMANO with 10 gears. Those who borrowed a wheel must return the wheel and retrieve one's own wheel at "Bicycle Wheel Claim" (Appendix 1 See area map (Ⅶ)) after the race, after the cargo truck has arrived at the area and 5:00 PM.
- ◆ Riders must change the borrowed wheel with one's own wheel on their own.

4. Dropping out or being eliminated from the race:

- ◆ Acts of pushing other riders are prohibited under any circumstance and failing to obey the rule will result in being eliminated from the race.
- $\ \, \blacklozenge$ Riders dropping out of the race must return their numbers to a race commissar.
- Organizer establishes several control gates—those gates are called or written as "check points in some other documents—and cut-off times are established at those gates. Failing to pass through each of the gates before those times will result in being eliminated from the race. Disqualified riders must not continue riding back to the finish line.
- ♦ Disqualified riders must follow the commissars' directions to pull over, and return one's numbers and transponder.
- ◆ Riders who are disqualified at a control gate will be picked up by a broom wagon which will take those riders back to the race head quarters; so when you are eliminated from the race, stop competition and wait for the broom wagon to pick you up. Your bicycle will be loaded and transported by a cargo truck dispatched by the organizer. Retrieve your bicycle at "Bicycle Claim" (Appendix 1 See area map (V)) after the race, after the cargo truck has arrived at the area and 5:00 PM.

5. Handlebars:

- ◆ Competitors must wear certified helmets of Japan Cycling Federation.
- ◆ Competitors must conform the Japan Cycling Federation competition rules as road racer. (**1) (Reference: Japan Cycling Federation competition rules URL http://goo.gl/Fz4wlw)
 - (**1) A drop handle only. Do not allow the additional attachment, the brake is not normal behavior, different inch size between front and back wheels.
- ◆ Competitors must dressed as in line with the Japan Cycling Federation competition rules in Article 3, Section 8. (There is video judgment only the top winners after the end of the race.)
- ◆ Use of disc brakes are prohibited. (There is video judgment only the top winners after the end of the race.)
- ◆ There are gear ratio regulations for men and women of less than 18 years of age and men and women in high school as of January 1, 2015. (There are inspections only the top winners after the end of the race.)
 **Derailleur adjustment does not accept, such as that does not move.

Cycling Sports Competition for Citizens: Rules for Road Races

6. Assembly and start:

- ◆ Rider must gather in front of Nago 21st Century Gymnasium 30 min. before the race starts. (Appendix 1 See area map (II))
- ♦ After arriving at the area, follow the directions of the race staffs to proceed to the start line.
- ◆ As for starting order, riders must line up in ascending order from left to right. The athlete's number number 50th assumes it a seeded player. The players except it line up on a first-come-first-served basis.

7. Affixing racing numbers, helmet numbers, frame numbers, and a transponder:

- ◆ Improper affixation of numbers is subject to penalties. Protests against the penalties will not be accepted.
- ◆ Frame numbers must be affixed on the front frame or seat post. As for helmet numbers, one number must be affixed on the front and two numbers on the sides.
- ◆ As for a transponder, Matrix Inc.'s automatic time measurement system will be used, so each rider must affix his transponder on the front fork. After the race is over, return the transponder at a designated place. (Appendix 1 See area map (Ⅶ))

8. After Crossing the Finish Line

◆ After crossing the finish line, riders must follow the directions given by the race staffs and return to Nago fishery port. If you park your car at the port, load your bicycle on to your car and wait till the awards/closing ceremony to start at Nago public market's parking space. There will be no space for you to park your bicycle in the down town, so walk from the port to the market.

9. Points to be careful about:

- ◆ Riders must ride safely, paying attention to warning signs and guard fences.
- Refer to event booklet for points to be careful about. If there is a new point, the organizer will publicize it at the opening ceremony.

10. Awards (Top finishers will be awarded in order of results)

- ◆ The organizer presents a champion jersey, a cup, a certificate and an extra prize to 1st finisher.
- ◆ The organizer presents a certificate, a medal and an extra prize each to 2nd to 3rd finishers.
- ◆ The organizer presents a certificate and an extra gift to each 4th, 5th and 6th finishers.
- ** The 1st through 3rd finishers will be awarded on the podium while 4th through 6th finishers will be awarded at "Awarding Center." The 1st through 3rd finishers must gather in the stage by 15 minutes. The person who does not attend is disqualified and may be demoted.
- * All the fourth to sixth places winner will be awarded at the Recognition Center (Nago indoor playground)

11. Sprint Award (Municipality Mayors' Awards)

- ◆ A rider who passed a Sprint Point in first place will be awarded with Spring Prize, a certificate and an extra prize from a mayor of each of those municipalities below. Each spring point will be indicated with a signboard and white line.
- ◆ Special Prize Points

12. Hill Climb Awards:

◆ The particepant who passed through a defined mountainous point (Terukubisan summit) at the 1st-position will be awarded the king of the mountains.

The Citizen Road Race 210km/140km both king of the mountains is 2 times to give diplomas and prizes (the Yanbaru set) respectively.

13. Traffic Lanes:

- ◆ As for the use of traffic lanes, priorities will be given to emergency vehicles and commissaire vehicles: when riders see such vehicles, they have to travel the left side of the lane. If it is not safe traveling the left side and riders have no choice but traveling the right lane, follow the directions given by the commissaires and use the right lane. After passing the unsafe section of the course, go back to the left lane.
- ◆ Traveling on the right lane all the time may result in being eliminated from the race or downgraded.

14. Penalties:

◆ Failing to follow the rules and regulations for the citizens' road races may result in being penalized with being degraded or disqualified based on decisions made by commissaires. Protesting against the penalties will not be accepted under any circumstances.

15. Petition of Objection:

- ◆Objection will be submitted with denoted by the deposit money (5,000 yen) in writing. (Written objection can be received at the convention secretariat. If the objection was observed, this deposit money will be refunded. Excuse of not knowing the rules can not be the reason for the objection.
- •Petition of Objection for Citizen Road Race 50km is until 10:30.
- •Petition of Objection for Citizen Road Race 210km, 140km and 100km is until 14:45.

(Those who has disqualified at 14:45, must submit within 30min. after the notice.)

* For any objections after the above-mentioned time, not be accepted.




17. Race manners:



2. Frame Number · Helmet Number

The numbers and color of the tag on your back must match the number and color on your helmet. (There is no helmet numbers on the helmet.)


3. The tag number for the winner of the previous year (Only for Race Programs) The winner of the previous year will be given the first number of each race, if they participate.

4. Mounting transponder chip

- · Because it measures automatically, transponder tip is attached to the front fork of the bicycle.
- · Receive it at the "Registration/Packet Pick Up Area (1)" and return it after the race at "Return Transponder Chips Area (6)".

5. Attention on mounting tag number and transponder chip

The mounting of the tag number is as shown below. Do not shrink the tag number. The transponder chip is attached according to the instruction manual distributed with the tag number at the time of participation registration.



Convention Rules and Regulations CYCLING

1. Cycling Program includes 8 categories

- Events: 1) Touring Around Okinawa Island Course
 - ③ Cycling Tour for Izena Island
 - **5** Challenge Cycling Course
 - (7) Barrier-Free Cycling

- 2 Yanbaru Century Ride
- 4 le Island Family Cycling
- 6 Onna Villege Family Cycling

The cycling program IS NOT a competition and WILL NOT be timed. Try to make it through the finish line safely.

2. Event Regulations and Notes

1 Follow the Japanese Traffic Rules:

- The Touring Division the above listed categories is not a competition and will not be timed.
- · Courses are not under traffic control.
- · Public roads are used for the race; please do not chase or interrupt other riders. Please maintain a single file formation while riding.
- · Please observe the traffic signals as well as stop signs and come to a complete stop at red lights.
- · To prevent obstruction of traffic, accompanying/support vehicles are prohibited.

2 Directions Given by Staff:

- Please do not pass the pace car. (Tour de Okinawa staff cannot help in the event of an accident or provide aid at aid/support stations.)
- · The participants who has judged not to be in time by the administration time at lunch location, collects it once and may move it to the lunch location. Please follow the instructions of the staff.
- You will be asked to stop riding if staff considers your behavior to be dangerous.

3 Maintenance of your bicycle.

- · It is your responsibility to maintain your own bicycle or to have a bike mechanic at a bike shop maintain your bike for you. A poorly maintained bicycle should not be used for the cycling.
- · While on the course, all necessary repairs will be performed by the rider. The support car will not stop.
- · While cycling, you must wear a bicycle helmet.
- · Bicycles should be equipped with lights and reflectors. Please use them during early morning and evening hours and while in tunnels.

4 About On Course Accidents:

- In the event of an accident, staff will provide emergency aid but afterward it is the responsibility of the rider to seek appropriate medical care.
- · If you wish to retire, please follow staff instructions.

· Participants are covered disability insurance by the organiser (visit hospital for 2000 yen / hospital stay for 3000 yen / death or sequelae for highest at 5,000,000 yen).

However, please buy other insurance on your own if the above insurance is not enough for you.

- 6. Shipping your bicycle by ferry:
 - · Transportation of the bicycle by ferry, will be placed in superimposed on the other bicycle. There is also a possibility to get cracks in the body frame under the influence of waves, etc., however, the organizer is not taking any responsibiliteis.

(Size [21cm × 24cm]

- It is advised to bring sufficient snacks to avoid medical problems and performance issues
- The course follows public roadways so be cautious of oncoming and passing traffic.

Manage boarding on ferry

- Motobu Port le Port: Immediately after arriving at the port, a ferry can be boarded according to the officer's directions. (le Island Family Cycling)
- Unten Port Nakada Port: Immediately after arriving at the port, a ferry can be boarded according to the officer's directions. (Cycling Tour for Izena Island and Bus Tour)

4. Certificate of Completion




